Its camps are unlike any adventure you have ever imagined.

You will be intimately immersed in relationship with Women Elders who are among Australia's last Custodians of the Ancestral Ways. They grew up in the desert before the arrival of Whitefella Culture in their lands.

You will engage in Community, Ceremony, Country and Cultural Awakening workshops under the Women Elders' guidance.

Our Camps are a unique opportunity for you to connect with the Tjukurrpa (Dreaming/LifeForce). Relationship to Tjukurrpa is the key to healing the cultural trauma impacting Indigenous peoples and central to improving inter-cultural relations.

You will receive training in the Art of the Tilitja/Culture Worker, developing and improving your skills for working with Indigenous peoples and communities.
